#### **MISSIONS**

Pray for Pamela Stonehouse in Itu, Brazil - Arrives home Saturday, August 13 at 10:27 AM.

"The church here in Itu has begun holding a monthly Worship service all in English. It has been a great way of building bridges between our readers and the church members and has attracted many other English speaking people who we have not been able to accommodate into our one on one LST classes. I am co-teaching a Sunday school class for the adolescents. It has helped me with speaking in Portuguese in front of large groups. We are doing a study based in the book of Psalms. My Friday night English Bible study at the language school "Centro Cultural Americano" continues to meet weekly. The group has grown a bit in number and we have 3 or 4 new people who are coming on a

regular basis. We are coming to the end of a series about the questions that Jesus asked and what they meant to the people of that day and how they can be applied to our own lives today.

This week there are 2 campaign groups here working with us. A group from Oklahoma Christian and Aggies for Christ from Texas A&M University. They arrived last Sunday and we spent the week taking them to visit different English schools and high schools inviting the young people to a camp that was held Thurs, Friday and Saturday. We had 10 young people attend who were the result of our visits to the schools. One young man, Mauricio, who I have been studying with for almost 2 years, came and he brought his 14 year old cousin, Felipe. They both enjoyed the camp and I had some wonderful discussions with Mauricio about God's love for all people. Please pray for Mauricio. He is searching for fulfillment in his life and has not yet realized that the fulfillment he seeks can only come from God. This morning we were happy to see most of the "new" kids from camp at the church for worship service. A response commonly heard by these young people at camp when asked if they were members of the church or if they were visiting the camp was that they were not YET members. This is an exciting response.

Much preparation is being done for another campaign group that will arrive from Highland Church of Christ in Abilene in July. We will be holding a week long camp with them as well as many other activities which are being planned now."
