Hello to all of you back home in Saskatoon!

I can hardly believe that in 8 short weeks from when I am writing this that I will be home with all of you. With that reality comes many mixed feelings. I am excited to come back to my family and friends there but I am very saddened to leave my family and friends here. I ask you all to please pray for me now as I prepare for this transition and please continue to pray for me after I arrive in Canada. I know it is going to be an emotional time for me.

I would like to give you all a bit of an outline of what my last few months here in Brasil are going to look like. Incredibly, this is my last week of LST reading sessions and other English Bible classes. I think that fact is bringing it home more and more that my time really is drawing to an end. Friday morning (July1st) a group of 58 Americans from the Highland church of Christ in Abilene, Texas are arriving. Salena and I have been busy making preparations for many of the activities that they will be doing while they are here. One of the main events is going to be a camp. The camp will be held from the 3rd to the 7th of July. Please pray that this camp will be used by God to reach many lost souls. I will be acting as a counselor, small group leader, and translator. Pray that God will give me the words to say and help me to be an example to the new people who will be coming.

On the 7th of July Salena's father will arrive. He will stay with us until July 19th when he and Salena will return to the US together. The group from Abilene will be here until July 11th. After they leave Salena and I plan to put Glen, her father, to work helping us to move out of our apartment. If all goes well I will spend the week following Salena's departure in Salvador visiting with Travis and Alicia and their team. I'm still trying to make arrangements. I will return to Itu with about 2 weeks before I am to head back to Canada. My agenda is already full of appointments to spend time with readers and other friends. I know that the time is going to go by so quickly. It is good because I will be able to see all of you again but it is sad at the same time because I will be leaving my life here in Brasil. I thank you all for your thoughts and prayers. Your e-mails of encouragement mean so much to me right now. Thank you! I will see you soon! Pamela
